Upper Lisle Road Bridge to be Closed for Repairs

(TOWN OF TRIANGLE, NY) The Broome County Department of Public Works announced today that Upper Lisle Road Bridge in the Town of Triangle will be closed July 16, 2018 through September 28, 2018.

The bridge closure is scheduled to begin at 7AM on July 16. The bridge is expected to re-open to traffic on or about 4 p.m. on September 28, 2018.

All local traffic will need to seek alternate routes while the bridge is closed. Please plan your travel accordingly.

The Upper Lisle Road Bridge is a steel truss bridge that currently has paint that is peeling and exposing the steel to rust. If this is not corrected, the corrosion will continue and eventually require bridge closure. The project will clean and paint the steel and include minor steel repairs including repairs to the deck grating and secondary members and approach railing replacement.

The Otselic River boat launch will continue to be open with access from the west side of the bridge via Upper Lisle/Whitney Point Road.
