Proposed Redevelopment Project of Former "Windsor Inn"

Non-Profit Applies for Funding from County Executive's Small Community Fund

(VILLAGE OF WINDSOR, NY) Broome County Executive Jason Garnar joined representatives from the Windsor Community Revitalization Organization, Inc. (WRCO) today to announce a proposed project for the reuse and repurposing of the former Windsor Inn located at 123 Main Street.

Ron Harting, Village of Windsor Mayor, and Carolyn Price, Town of Windsor Supervisor, were also at today's announcement.

The Windsor Community Revitalization Organization, Inc., a nonprofit, has applied for \$2,500 in funding from the County Executive's Small Community Fund. This funding would be used to complete a feasibility study for this proposed project.

The WRCO has plans to transform the Windsor Inn into a multi-use building with housing and commercial space. This building would be an anchor in the village of Windsor.

"The current complex at 123 Main St. is in deplorable condition. The WRCO has plans to reuse and repurpose the building into upgraded apartments for low-moderate income levels," said Jerry Redmon, President of the Windsor Community Revitalization Organization, Inc.

Applications to the Small Community Fund must be considered and approved by the county's Hotel-Motel Committee then drafted into a resolution to be considered by the Broome County Legislature.
