

# **BROOME COUNTY AUGUST 2018 FLOODING INFORMATION**

**Tip fee waiver is for Broome County residential flood debris only.  
The tip fee will be waived from Wednesday, 8/15/18 to Wednesday 8/29/18.**

## **LANDFILL INFO**

- The Broome County Landfill operating hours:
  - Commercial haulers 7:00am-2:45pm Mon-Sat.
  - Residential haulers 7:00am-2:45pm Mon-Friday ; 7:00am-11:45am Saturday
- Hazardous Waste, Scrap Metal, Electronics, Tires and Refrigeration Units will be accepted under the Division's regular policy. These items are to be brought to the Landfill directly by the resident. These items are **not** to be mixed into the waste collected at the curb or in roll-off containers.

## **Important Notes**

- All residents must bring two (2) copies of the sign tip fee waiver form.
- Waiver request forms are for flood debris only.
- **These guidelines apply to residents directly hauling material to the landfill and to any resident that contracts with a private hauler.**
- **Dumpsters used for flood debris are not permitted to have the following materials in it:**

**No Freon units (dehumidifiers, freezers, refrigerators, air conditioners)  
No white goods/appliances (stove, washer, dryer)  
NO hazardous waste (paint, stains, varnish, pesticides, etc.)  
No monitors, computer towers, printers  
No televisions**
