All participants must provide their OWN candy (factory sealed) for distribution. Decorations must be family-appropriate. Vehicles will be assigned a registration number.

Additional regulations:

- Broome County will not provide candy.
- No amplified music.
- No electricity will be provided.
- Selling and distribution of promotional literature is prohibited at this event.
- Participants may include a sign with their display, indicating the name of the business or organization, if desired; Signs may not exceed 11x17 inches.
- Vehicles may arrive beginning at 11:30 a.m. on the date of the event
- Vehicles will not be permitted to move or leave the parking lot until the conclusion of the event.
