### **Broome County Announces New Director of Office for Aging (OFA)**

(BINGHAMTON, NY) Broome County Executive Jason Garnar is pleased to announce the appointment of Lisa Schuhle to serve as the Director of the Broome County Office for Aging (OFA).

The Broome County Legislature approved this appointment through a resolution in its February legislative session.

“I am excited for the opportunity to serve permanently as Director,” said Schuhle. “Broome County Office for Aging has a reputation for being one of the best in the state. I am looking forward to maintaining the high standards the agency is known for in serving the older adults in Broome County. “

She has been serving as Acting Director since October 2017 when former Director Jamie Kelly left the county to take a position with the New York State Office for People with Developmental Disabilities.

Schuhle has been working for the Broome County OFA since 1986. She has held several positions including Field Supervisor for the Foster Grandparent Program and Coordinator for Health and Wellness.

From 2007 to 2011, she was the Aging Service Program Coordinator for the Yesteryears Adult Day Program, overseeing two adult day programs. In 2011 she took over as the Aging Services Program Coordinator in the Information and Assistance Unit of the Broome County OFA, a position she held until stepping in as Acting Director.
